Sedona - 90 minutes north of Phoenix, a Mecca for lovers of nature, arts, crafts and photography, and truly a unique, special place – from its canyons to the creeks and sculptured red rocks to the many well-designed homes nestled along the roads that wind through sandstone spires. Featuring what Native Americans consider the spiritual vortex of the Southwest and sublime red rock formations, the area challenges many national parks in beauty.

Heard Museum & Desert Botanical Gardens - begins at The Desert Botanical Gardens. Founded in 1939, it has flourished into one of the best botanical gardens in the world and the only one whose mission is to focus solely on desert plant life. This tour is an unbeatable southwest experience, which acquaints you with the diversity of the Sonoran Desert and the resourcefulness of its native people.

Hummer Adventure - Experience the excitement that made National Geographic Adventures vote this Hummer Tour in the "Top 100 Adventures in America!" An unforgettable experience, and excitement of a lifetime in the most serious 4x4 on Earth. Go where no other vehicle can go. Defy the terrain and the elements, explore the unexplored, leaving the crowd behind on a unique adventure in the Sonoran Desert.

Cattle Drive - Remember Bonanza? Here's your chance to saddle-up and participate in one of the most exciting experiences of the Wild West on a customized Cattle Drive. Drive the herd with experienced wranglers. Cut twenty or so head of cattle from the corral and drive them out on the reservation. When the steers have quenched their thirst at the river, it's time to round them up and get them back to the corral. Get that adrenaline going!

Cooking Class - Chefs provide detailed instructions, demonstration of cooking techniques and unveil Southwest, Mexican, or Native American dishes indigenous to our area. When the food is prepared, the class enjoys a sit-down dinner and partakes in the "fruits of their labor." Participants will take home helpful cooking tips, great Southwest recipes and a full "filling" experience – and they don't even have to do the dishes!

Grand Canyon - Journey north in a deluxe motorcoach to one of the most scenic highways in North America. Taliesin West - Frank Lloyd Wright, the 20th century's greatest architect, literally created Taliesin West "out of the desert." He and his apprentices gathered rocks from the desert floor and sand from the washes to build this great desert masterpiece. A visit to this National Historic Landmark is particularly meaningful since the buildings are used for the purposes for which they are designed; the site still serves as a living, working, educational facility with an on-site architectural firm. Follow this with a visit to Cosanti, the headquarters of Paolo Soleri, who originally came from Italy to study with Wright.

Hiking Tour - Venture into the lush desert and learn all about the unique flora, fauna, geology, and history with knowledgeable guides. Exploring on foot is the most intimate and educational way to experience the desert and enjoy an up close look at the elements that comprise the Sonoran Desert.
