How To Choose A Partner

- Don't always choose your closest friend.
- Raise your hand to silently signal "I need a partner".
- Look at the group and find someone else with their hand raised and make eye contact with them.
- In a happy tone of voice, ask "Will you please be my partner?"
- If someone asks you to be their partner, answer "Sure! Thank You!"
