From time to time we find ourselves with interesting models that probably do not have the mass appeal to be brought to market through normal means. The setting up of full production runs just cannot be economically justified. They can however be produced in small numbers using preproduction casting.

We have two such models at the moment.



The Japanese Type 4 Light Tank Ke-Nu was a hybrid. With the introduction of the Shinhoto Chi-Ha's high-velocity 47mm gun the Japanese found themselves with numerous excess Type 97 Chi-Ha 57 mm turrets. They mounted over 100 of these on Type 95 Ha-Go hulls. Priced at \$37, crewman not included.



The Australians received Stuarts from both the US and Great Britain. Not all tanks were fitted with every modification but most common were the fitting turret base ring protectors, addition of stowage bins and equipment boxes, modifying the engine air intake, removal of the sponson machine guns and fitting blanking plates and fitting a periscope to Commander's Cupola. Priced at \$37, complete with one crewman from our assortment.
