15. Third and Fourth Seat Adjustments

Summary: Opening range for suit bids is wider. 1 No Trump and 1 Club are stronger. Major suit openers may be balanced on 4 cards for preemptive effect. All responses are the same as First and Second Seats.

Openings:

- 1 \heartsuit : any 17+ HCP hand
- 1 \spadesuit : 11-16, 4+ Hearts
- 1 \clubsuit : 11-16, 4+ Spades, denies Hearts
- 1 \diamonds : 11-16, 4+ 4+ Minors (2 \heartsuit invitation relay, 2 \spadesuit to play)
- 1NT: 14-16 (see strong No Trump structure)
- 2 \heartsuit , 2 \spadesuit : 11-16, 6+ single suiter
- 2 \clubsuit , 2 \diamonds : Weak Two (undisciplined 3rd seat, solid 4th seat)
- 2NT: 3rd seat 5-5 Minors weak, 4th seat 6 \heartsuit -4 \spadesuit 11-16
- 3 \heartsuit , 3 \spadesuit : preempt
- 3 \clubsuit , 3 \diamonds : preempt
- 3NT: Acol 3NT, to play
- 4 \heartsuit , 4 \spadesuit , 4 \clubsuit , 4 \diamonds : to play

Particular care should be taken to anticipate an 11-13 balanced hand with a 4-card Major. **Overcalls**

All ranges are shifted up 2 HCP. Light actions are not forbidden, with good reason.
