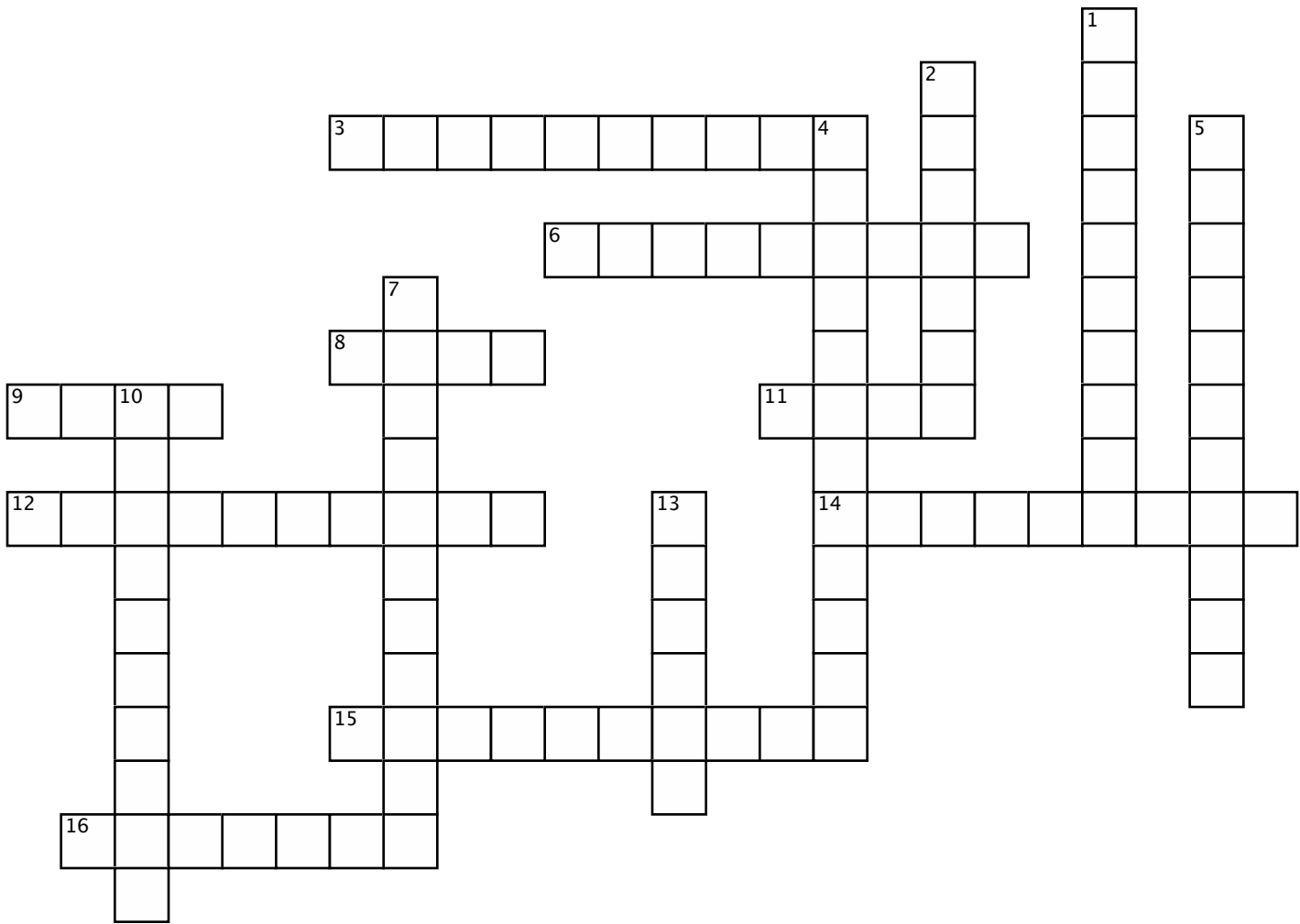


# Pollination Puzzle

3. Darwin's orchid, *Angraecum sesquipedale*
6. Western Yucca, *Hesperoyucca whipplei*
8. Shakes pollen from the anther
9. Grasses & oaks
11. Very small, short tubular flowers, often low-growing
12. Mountain blue-curly, *Trichostema parishii*
14. Rothrock Lobelia, *Lobelia dunnii* var. *serrata*
15. Pale colored flowers, open at night
16. Flowers with dead-animal smell

1. Manzanita, nightshade, & shooting star
2. Clumsy pollinators, probably the first pollinating insects
4. Woolly blue-curly, *Trichostema lanatum*
5. Stream orchid, *Epipactis gigantea*
7. Strong perfume scent in the day
10. Vinegarweed, *Trichostema lanceolatum*
13. A pollen carrier
