 - b. 17:10-16 eating of blood forbidden
 - (1) vv 10-12, prohibition against eating blood
 - (2) vv 13-14, the blood of hunted animals
 - (3) vv 15-16, concerning the blood of dead animals.
 2. 18, sexual impurities forbidden
 3. 19, Various laws

- a. 19:1-4, be holy, fear every man's father or mother; keep the Sabbath, turn from idols.
 - b. 19:5-8, eating the peace offering
 - c. 19:9-10, gleaning
 - d. 19:11, 12, do not steal
 - e. 19:13, 14, do not oppress others
 - f. 19:15, 16, be no respecter of persons
 - g. 19:17, 18, do not hate your brother

- D. Instructions for Priestly Life (21-27)
- 1. 21:1-9, do not defile yourself with the dead
 - 2. 21:10-15, marry a virgin
 - 3. 21:16-24, no Aaronic priest with blemish can offer sacrifices.
 - 4. 22:1-9, If he should be made unclean...
 - 5. 22:10-16, no one is to eat the anointed portion for the priests
