Each unit in our district is strongly encouraged to nominate a volunteer for this special award. One award is made per unit per year and is presented at the annual district dinner by a member of your unit.

Typically, it is given to a person that has assured the unit’s success through tireless effort and commitment. The candidate does not need to be a registered leader.

Usually a selection committee from the unit nominates a person that they would like to recognize for their service. The nominee should be present at the dinner to receive the award.

This award dates back to the 1980’s when an Illinois District (currently Indian Prairie and Thunderbird Districts) Scouter passed away. His wish was to recognize volunteers in the packs, troops, crews and teams for their service. We continue this tradition in both Thunderbird and Indian Prairie Districts.
