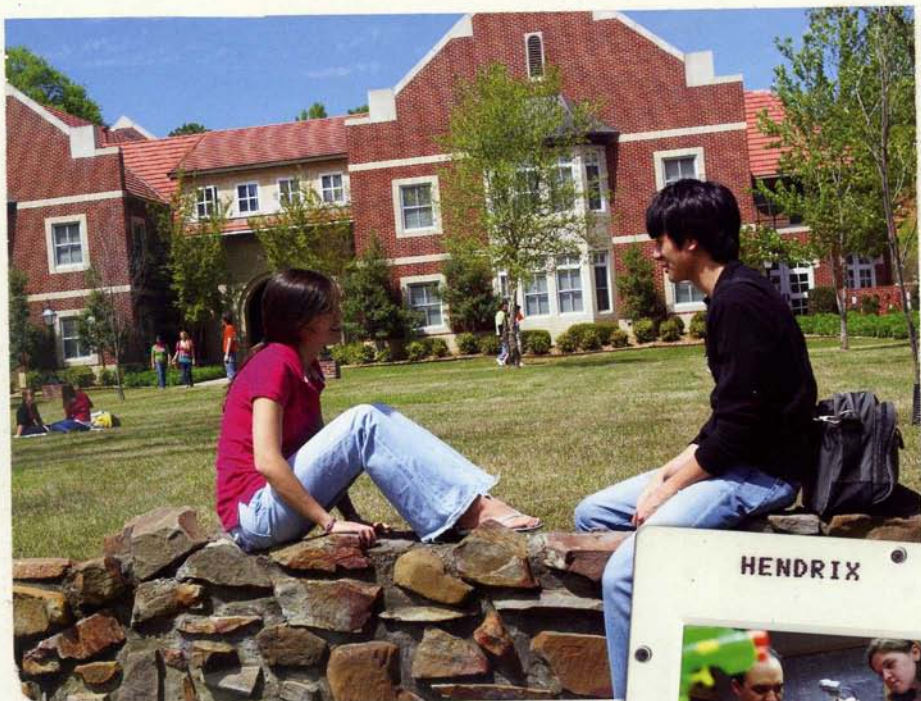

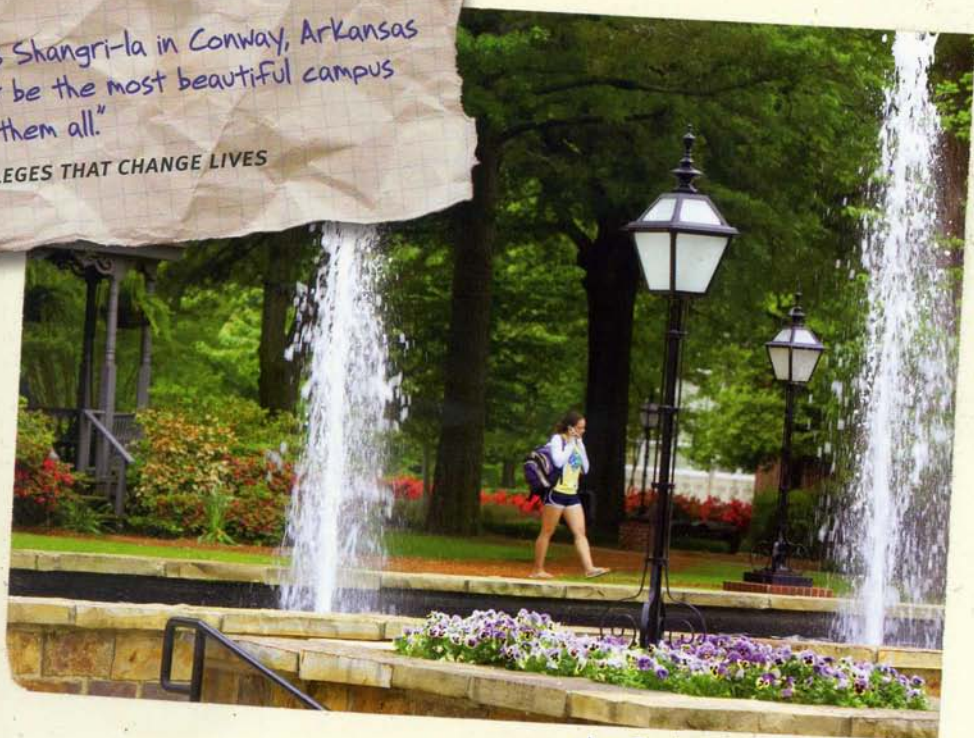
Coming Soon! Student Life and Technology Center

The new \$26 million **STUDENT LIFE AND TECHNOLOGY CENTER** — a high-touch, high-tech campus “living room” where students and faculty can connect — will open its doors in 2010. It will include:

- ▶ An Educational Technology Center (ETC) integrates state-of-the-art teaching, learning, and social technology into every aspect of the college experience.
- ▶ Offices for the Odyssey program, student media and organizations, Student Affairs, and Academic Advising and Support.
- ▶ A religious life center, a dining hall, a lounge, a room, post office, and programming.

As a Hendrix graduate, you will stand out when competing for employment opportunities or acceptance by professional and graduate schools. And you'll benefit from a network of alumni contacts that spans the world.

- ▶ Our graduates include six Rhodes Scholars, 14 Fulbright Scholars, 26 Watson Fellows, 21 Goldwater Scholars, two Truman Scholars, two Jack Kent Cooke Scholars, and a Marshall Scholar.
- ▶ Hendrix graduates who immediately enter the job market report obtaining employment within six months of graduation.
- ▶ More than half of our graduates enroll in graduate or professional school within two years of graduation.
- ▶ Our graduates' acceptance rate at law schools stands at over 90% and the acceptance rate at medical schools is 85% (nearly double the national average).
- ▶ Hendrix is ranked 28th in the nation among all colleges and universities for the percentage of graduates who earn Ph.D.s within six years of graduation.
- ▶ Hendrix is one of just 40 institutions in the country selected for inclusion in *Colleges That Change Lives* by Loren Pope, former education editor for *The New York Times*.
