

Community Description

The Town of Bozrah, located in New London County, has an approximate population of 2400 as recorded on the 2000 census showing a 2.6 % growth in the past decade. Bozrah operates under a Board of Selectman/Town Meeting form of government, and a seven member Board of Education oversees the public education system. The town has light industry and manufacturing, freight and transportation facilities, small businesses and agriculture. Many wage-earners commute to Hartford, Norwich or the nearby casinos for employment. The 2000 per capita income was \$26,600, and 88% of the adult population had at least a high school diploma. Bozrah does not have its own public library and uses the Otis Library in Norwich, CT and the school library. There is a Congregational, Baptist and Roman Catholic church in town, a very active Fire Department and a Senior Center. The Town maintains a park and recreation field and in the summer of 2005 erected a new playground. Children and teenagers participate in a range of activities including Scouts, junior EMT, the Cadet Fire program, sports teams and programs organized by the Town Recreation Commission, and PTO activities.
