This upcoming season should lend itself to even more exciting events. Currently we have over 30 students interested in joining our program.

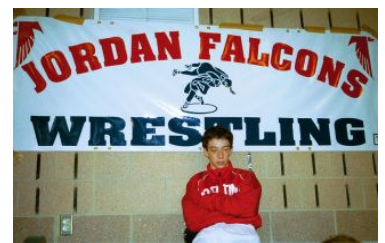
We have added some new trips to our schedule. This year we will be heading to Goldsboro on December 9 to compete in the Eagle Invitational, held by Rosewood High School. We will also be heading to Eden Morehead on January 19 - 20 to compete in the Sarah Wilkes Tournament.

We will be led by two PAC-VI All-Conference selections (Jay Marko and Eric Lyons). Our team will be led by a core group of seniors Bennet Pike, Brian Reynolds, and Jay Marko.

This will be year two of Head Coach Phil Davanzo's three year plan. He will be looking to secure a post season berth in the NCHSAA's State Duals, as well as qualifying five wrestlers for the individual state championships. Along with those two goals he'd like to see the number of wrestlers, on the end of the year's roster, to be roughly 28 wrestlers (with the long term goal of having 35 wrestlers at years end).

We will wrestle roughly 23 dual matches this season and five tournaments across the state of North Carolina. During those days we will be seeing the likes of 2X defending 4A State Champs Cary, 3A State Champs Morehead,

State Runner-up Mount Tabor, and perennial South Carolina power Summersville. Needless to say that our schedule will provide us an opportunities to see the best competition, helping us achieve our goals.
