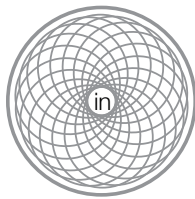

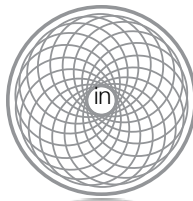
The Dice: *Their Employment and Stock Options*

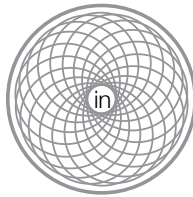

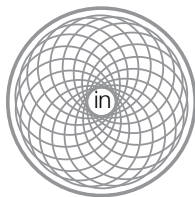
Where and When: Stately Cashington Estates, February 14th

How Your Secret Portfolio Works

The Roach commands you to be free. This page may or may not be used in the game, all players decide beforehand. It's all or nothing. During character creation, fill out **Your Secret Portfolio** with the juiciest, nastiest secrets your Roach brain can imagine. These secrets are facts. They become part of the game.

When drawing the first roach card, you must divulge the first secret to your target sometime during the event. This is in addition to your regular roach duties. When drawing your second Roach card, you must reveal the second secret to your target and so on, even if the roach card is discarded. Secrets can stack. Each secret revealed gains one reputation at the end of the event. You do not have to reveal this page until the end of the game, only announce a secret was revealed.

Also, feel free to lie when ever it suits your needs, even before or after being compelled to tell the truth.

Why must this family be built upon a house of lies? Because that's just part of **Family Business**.
