

2009 Grad Night Party

Special Student Circumstances Policies

1. If your student requires prescription medication that must be taken during the 2009 Grad Night Party --

Prescription medications must be in their original, marked container and carried in the one gallon sized clear zip lock bag.

Student's parent or legal guardian must write, date and sign a detailed note giving the student permission to take the medication and describing when the medication should be taken.

Unless prior arrangements are made, medications will be held in the students zip lock bag in the secure bag check room and will be made available to the student when needed.

2. If your student requires an Epipen --

Student may carry the Epipen with them in a pocket. Parent or legal guardian must write, date and sign a note authorizing that the student can carry and use the Epipen. Keep this note in the one gallon zip lock bag.

3. If your student requires Insulin Kit --

Insulin kits can be kept in one gallon zip lock bag - student may bring two zip lock bags if insulin kit and student possessions will not fit in one bag. LABEL ALL ITEMS. Parent or legal guardian must include a detailed note giving student permission to carry and use kit. Student may carry the kit with them during the party if necessary - please indicate this on parent note.

4. Feminine hygiene products --

Any necessary feminine hygiene products can be brought in the one gallon zip lock bag. For privacy, they may be placed in a small cosmetic type bag in their ONE zip lock bag. Cosmetic bag will be checked to be sure that only feminine hygiene products are inside.

5. Desired but unnecessary items --

Please do NOT bring:

Make up of any kind

Lotions or creams (unless medically necessary - must be in prescription container & include note from parent)

Hair products (a comb can be brought in zip lock bag in case student swims)

Water bottles or reusable beverage containers - not allowed on bus, will be discarded at HHS

Toothpaste / toothbrush, razor. Almost anything else - students will be home Friday morning.
