## Kindergarten Notes

The name of our new Kindergarten (and school) is Good Shepherd Lutheran School. Our school day will run from 8:10 am until 2:20 pm Monday through Friday.

We will cap our enrollment for the 2005-2006 school year at 20 students.

Our tuition and registration fee schedule is: A **nonrefundable** registration fee of \$125 will be due by May 15<sup>th</sup>. After May 15<sup>th</sup> the **nonrefundable** registration fee will be \$175. This will guarantee enrollment in our Kindergarten class.

Tuition for the 05-06 school year will be \$3000 per student.

Advertisements about our school were put in the *Mankato Free Press* during the week of March 7-11 to coincide with National Lutheran Schools week and on Monday, March 14<sup>th</sup>. We also have advertising in the *Home Magazine*.
