



## DOT PEBBLES KIT DOLLS - 'FiFi' outfit

You will need:

### Yarn and extras

For the A-line dress:

**MC** 50g x 4-ply/ finger weight yarn - I used Jaegar Baby Merino 4-Ply shade 127 - Blue Ball

50cm/ 1/2 yd magenta coloured Fluffy trim/ marabou feathers for the frou-frou

20cm (x 6mm/ 1/4in) length navy blue velvet ribbon

For the Slippers uppers: 1 x skein Anchor or DMC stranded embroidery thread in silver

2 x 6mm/ 1/4in ribbon roses

For the Beret:

Oddment **MC** (Jaegar Baby Merino 4-Ply shade 127) and oddment **D** (Jaegar Baby Merino 4-Ply shade 123 - dream - **D**)

### Needles

Pair 3mm/ US 2 Needles

Dressmaker's sewing needle

### A-line Dress Back and front alike

In MC cast on 44 stitches.

Beginning on a Knit row, stocking stitch (*knit 1 row, purl 1 row, repeat*), 14 rows.

**1st shaping row:** \*Knit 7 stitches, knit 2 stitches together, repeat from \* once, knit 8, \*\* knit 2 stitches together, knit 7, repeat from \*\* once. (40 stitches)

Work 13 rows in stocking stitch.

**2nd shaping row:** \*Knit 6 stitches, knit 2 stitches together, repeat from \* once, knit 8, \*\* knit 2 stitches together, knit 6, repeat from \*\* once. (36 stitches)

Work 13 rows in stocking stitch.

**3rd shaping row:** \*Knit 5 stitches, knit 2 stitches together, repeat from \* once, knit 8, \*\* knit 2 stitches together, knit 5, repeat from \*\* once. (32 stitches)

Work 13 rows in stocking stitch.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: Cast off 3 stitches at the beginning of this and the next row. (26 stitches)

**Next row:** Knit 3 stitches, knit 2 together, knit to the last 5 stitches, knit 2 together, knit 3. (24 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl.

Continue shaping working the last 2 rows until there are 20 stitches on the needle.

Cast off.T TO MAKE UP: Sew up the side seams.

TO WORK THE POLO NECK 2 alike:

Cast on 20 stitches in the blue wool, and work in rib for 5 rows as follows: \*Knit 1 stitch, purl 1, repeat from \* to the end of the row.

Change to the silver embroidery thread (use all six strands) and cast off in the silver thread.

Join the front polo to the back polo by sewing up the row ends, then carefully attach the cast on end of the polo neck band to the neck edge of the a line dress.

To complete the dress sew the frou frou to the hem beginning and ending at the back.

Cut the velvet ribbon in half widthways and sew each cut end to each side seam of the dress just below the arm hole, turning in raw ends to conceal.Tie a bow at the front.

### BERET Make in one piece:

Cast on 60 stitches in MC and work in rib as follows: \*Knit 1 stitch, purl 1, repeat from \* to the end of the row, for 6 rows.

The hat is then worked in the striped pattern using MC and D for 10 rows, at the same time following shapings:

STRIPE PATTERN: 2 D rows, 2 MC rows, 2 D rows, 2 MC, 2 D, then continue with the MC only, throughout.

SHAPINGS:

**Row 7:** Knit

**Row 8 and every alternate row:** Purl.

**Next row:** Knit 6, \*knit 1 stitch, make 1 stitch, knit 9, repeat from \* 4 times more, knit 1 stitch, make 1 stitch, knit 3. (66 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl.

**Next row:** Knit 7, \*knit 1 stitch, make 1 stitch, knit 10, repeat from \* 4 times more, knit 1 stitch, make 1 stitch, knit 3 stitches. (72 stitches)

Continue to increase in this way on every alternate row until there are 90 stitches on the needle, end on a purl row.

Work 4 rows straight in stocking stitch (*knit 1 row, purl 1 row, repeat*).

**Next row:** \*Knit 3 stitches together, knit 6 stitches, repeat from \* to the end of the row. (70 stitches)

Work 3 rows straight in stocking stitch.

**Next row:** \*Knit 3 stitches together, knit 7 stitches, repeat from \* to the end of the row. (56 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl.

**Next row:** Knit 1, \*knit 3 stitches together, knit 8 stitches, repeat from \* to the end of the row. (46 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl.

**Next row:** \*Knit 2 stitches together, repeat from \* to the end of the row. (23 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl.

**Next row:** Knit 1 \*knit 2 stitches together, repeat from \* to the end of the row. (12 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl.

**Next row:** \*Knit 2 stitches together, repeat from \* to the end of the row. (6 stitches)

Break off the wool and thread through the remaining stitches, draw up and fasten off.

TO MAKE UP: Sew up the back seam. Flop the top of the beret down to one side and hold in place with a stitch or two then stitch a ribbon rose in place on the side. See the photograph on the label for visual detail.

**SLIPPERS** Make 2 alike:

FOR THE SLIPPER UPPER:

Beginning at the toe end cast on 3 stitches in silver embroidery thread using all 6 strands.

**1st row:** Knit.

**Next row:** \*Knit 1 stitch, make 1 stitch, continue from \* 2 more times. (6 stitches)

Continue with the last 2 rows once more. (12 stitches)

Knit 5 more rows. Cast off

SOLE: Cast on 8 stitches in MC. Continue in stocking stitch (knit one row purl one row, repeat) for 14 rows. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP: Take each sole press flat and fold, with the purl stitches facing out, each row end to join under the sole. Oversew to join together. Then oversew the cast on edge - this will be the toe end, then the cast off edge. Shape the upper over the tip of your index finger then lay the upper over the toe end and sew in place with one strand of silver thread. Sew a ribbon rose to the top outer edge of each slipper.

## BOLERO

BACK: Using D cast on 25 stitches.

Begin with a purl row and work 13 rows in stocking stitch (*purl 1 row, knit 1 row, repeat*).

**Next row:** Cast off 2 stitches at the beginning of this and the next row. (21 stitches)

**Next row:** Knit 1 stitch, knit 2 stitches together, knit to the last 3 stitches, Knit 2 stitches together, knit 1. (19 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl.

Repeat the last 2 rows until there are 15 stitches on the needle.

Continue in stocking stitch for 2 more rows.

SHAPE RIGHT SHOULDER: Knit 5 stitches then turn the knitting to work on these 5 stitches.

**Next row:** (Purl 2 stitches together) twice, purl 1. (3 stitches)

**Next row:** Knit.

Cast off.

Rejoin the ball of wool to the remaining 10 stitches. Cast off 5 stitches. Knit to the end

SHAPE LEFT SHOULDER: Purl 5 stitches then turn the knitting to work on these 5 stitches.

**Next row:** (Knit 2 stitches together) twice, knit 1. (3 stitches)

Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT: Cast on 5 stitches, purl the 1st row.

**Next row:** (Knit 1, make 1) twice, knit to the end. (7 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl.

Repeat the last 2 rows until there are 13 stitches on the needle.

**Next row:** Knit.

**Next row:** Purl to last stitch, knit a stitch, make as stitch. (14 stitches)

**Next row:** Knit to last 4 stitches, (knit 2 stitches together). (12 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl.

**Next row:** Knit to the last 2 stitches, knit 2 stitches together. (11 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl.

Repeat the last 2 rows twice more. (9 stitches)

SHAPE FRONT: Knit 2 stitches together, knit to the last 2 stitches, knit 2 stitches together. (7 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl to the last 2 stitches, purl 2 together. (6 stitches)

**Next row:** Knit 2 stitches together, knit to the end of the row (5 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl to the last 2 stitches, purl 2 together. (4 stitches)

Repeat the first of the last 2 rows once more. (3 stitches)

Work 3 rows in stocking stitch. Cast off.

LEFT FRONT: Cast on 5 stitches.

**Next row:** Purl.

**Next row:** Knit to the last 2, (knit 1 stitch, make 1 stitch) twice. (7 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl 1, (purl 1 stitch, make 1 stitch) twice, purl to the end. (9 stitches)

**Next row:** Knit.

Rep last 2 rows until there are 13 stitches on the needle.

**Next row:** Purl.

**Next row:** Knit to the last stitch, knit 1 stitch, make 1 stitch. (10 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl to the last 4 stitches, (purl 2 stitches together) twice. (12 stitches)

**Next row:** Knit.

**Next row:** Purl to the last 2 stitches, purl 2 stitches together. (11 stitches)

**Next row:** Knit.

Repeat the last 2 rows once more. (9 stitches)

SHAPE FRONT: Purl 2 stitches together, purl to the last 2 stitches, purl 2 stitches together. (7 stitches)

**Next row:** Knit to the last 2 stitches, knit 2 together. (6 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl 2 stitches together, purl to the end. (5 stitches)

**Next row:** Knit to the last 2 stitches, knit 2 together. (4 stitches)

Repeat the first of the last 2 rows once more. (3 stitches)

Work 3 rows in stocking stitch. Cast off.

SLEEVES: Make 2 the same:

Cast on 13 stitches, stocking stitch 2 rows.

**Next row:** Knit 1 stitch, make 1 stitch, knit to the last stitch, knit 1, make 1. (15 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl.

Repeat the last 2 rows once more. (17 stitches)

Continue in stocking stitch for the next 6 rows.

**Next row:** Knit 1 stitch, make 1 stitch, knit to the last stitch, knit 1, make 1. (19 stitches)

Beginning on a purl row continue in stocking stitch for the next 23 rows.

**Next row:** Knit 2 stitches together, knit to the last 2, Knit 2 stitches together. (17 stitches)

**Next row:** Purl.

Repeat the last 2 rows until there are 5 stitches remaining on the needle.

Cast off.

TO MAKE UP: Steam all pieces flat. Match up the side seams front and back and join. Join the arm seams. Turn the bolero to the wrong side place each arm into the armholes right sides facing and join around the armhole edges. Turn right way out To complete work running stitch in the silver lamé along the front edges and around the back of the neck.
