



## **DOG DAY**

**WHAT:** DOG DAY is a Dutch Oven Gathering. This is open to any Scouter (Cub Scouter, Boy Scouter, or Venturer Adult) and their spouse. There will be no charge for this event.

**WHEN:** March 21, 2009 at CFE (Road Kill Café site). Site opens at 10:00 AM. Dishes must be ready for consumption by 5:00 PM.

**WHY:** So all of us can show off our Dutch Oven skills. We will be awarding a DO in each category.

### **HOW:**

- A. There will be two categories:
  - Main Dish (considered the center piece of a dinner (aka supper) meal)
  - Open Category (means anything you want to prepare in a DO other than the main dish)
- B. If you want to participate bring:
  - Your Dutch Oven(s)
  - Ingredients for what ever you will be cooking
  - Sufficient utensils to serve what you prepare
  - A 3"X5" card with your name, the name of the dish you are preparing, and the category you are entering.
- B. Manatee District will provide:
  - Charcoal
  - Trash bags
  - Liquid refreshments
  - Plates, silverware, and napkins
  - Two 12" Dutch Ovens for prizes
- C. At 5:00:
  - All participants plus any invited guests will gather to consume the prepared dishes.
  - Judges will evaluate each entrée and declare the winners. One winner per category will be declared.

**ANYTHING ELSE?** Yes, plan on fellowship, bragging, arguing, and swapping information on care, cleaning, and using a Dutch Oven.
