CUB SCOUT DAY CAMP INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

INTRODUCTION - The Cub Scout Day Camp program is designed to teach skills and develop attitudes that make a boy more self-reliant and more at home in the outdoors. It is fun with a purpose - to build character while providing a memorable experience to the boy. Day Camp is Cub Scouting at its best. Make sure your son gets to take part in this super activity.

TRANSPORTATION - Parents must transport their boys to and from camp each day. We encourage each Pack to car pool.

UNIFORM - The Day Camp uniform includes the Day Camp T-shirt, shorts, socks, and shoes. Socks and shoes must be worn at all times. Sandals or flip-flops are not permitted. One Day Camp T-shirt is provided with registration. Extra shirts are available for **\$10.00**; see the application for more information. Orders will be accepted before camp only. Each day please have your Scout bring with him sun screen, a hat, swim shorts, a towel, and a water bottle.

LUNCH - Each boy must bring a sack lunch and beverage each day.

SPECIAL EVENTS - In addition to all of the day to day fun, there will be several special events at camp. These will include special visitors after lunch.

VOLUNTEERS - Day Camp is staffed entirely by volunteers and we need your help. Adults serving as Den Leaders will be responsible for a den of boys and may be asked to assist in running activities. Whenever possible, these adults should plan to work all five days. If that is not possible, volunteers may alternate throughout the week. Only a volunteer who works all week will be given a Day Camp T-shirt and \$25.00 off of the registration fee of the Cub Scout of his or her choice.

KIDDIE KAMP - Kiddie Kamp is available at camp for the younger children of our volunteers only. Due to health regulations, kiddies must be toilet trained.
