Whether you are an experienced writer or just beginning to develop your craft, you may find that sometimes you need extra help.

The writing coach service provides personal support and practical advice for all kinds of writers. Advice can cover a range of issues including: starting, finishing, structure, improving the quality of your writing, and fixing specific problems. Support can cover themes such as finding focus, overcoming blocks, and tackling isolation. Coaching aims to improve both your technical skills and also your working process.

The writing coach service is suitable for people working on all kinds of writing including: reports, essays, research papers, fiction, and non-fiction.

Coaching begins with a face to face session, lasting around fifty minutes. This usually takes place in the West End of Edinburgh at Direction (18 Walker Street, Edinburgh EH3 7LP). For organisational clients, sessions can also be run at your office. Later sessions can, if appropriate and you would prefer, take place over a cup of a coffee at a mutually convenient café. Depending on your needs, later work can sometimes take place on the phone or by email. The number and frequency of sessions can be varied to suit your needs.

Fees are calculated at £35/hour. The costs for any given piece of work will depend on the nature and amount of material that requires reading and comments as well as face to face, phone, or email contact time.
