

"to continue to report to 501 Courtlandt Avenue, Bronx, NY until further notice." and "under no circumstances are you to return to John F. Kennedy High School unless so authorized by me or Mr. Rotunno."

In your response, at our meeting, you indicated that you received this letter approximately a week after the date of the letter or approximately November 8th.

Nevertheless, you continued to ignore the above stated directives. In an undated letter from you, students' were informed about and urged to attend "Apple Soho School Night, on November 15th, at 7:00 p.m. On November 30th you met with students and asked them to deliver T-shirts to other students (statement by teacher, Kevin Kent) Student A indicated that he received T-shirts from you.

Student B – indicated that he was asked to deliver T-shirts to certain students. On December 2nd, Student C was asked to deliver shirts to fellow students that were from you. On December 7th, Student D was asked by a fellow student to deliver and distribute T-shirts that were given to her by you. Your acts have caused disruptions of school and classroom activities.

On December 13th, you again visited John F. Kennedy High School and were arrested for trespassing. (PRP#74750).


On December 19th, teacher Kevin Kent indicated that students complained to him because they were asked by you to distribute written articles, copies of which had been mailed to their homes. Your insubordinate behavior continues to have a negative and disruptive effect on the students and the day-to-day activities of the school.

At the meeting, I furnished you with copies of witness statements with regard to the above described incidents.

At the conclusion of the meeting, I repeated my directive to you to report daily, until further notice, to 501 Courtlandt Avenue, and not to return to John F. Kennedy High School without permission from me or Mr. Rotunno. You were further directed to cease and desist all activities involving John F. Kennedy High School and not to further harass and disrupt school activities through further contact with students, in person or via e-mail.

Based on the foregoing, I conclude that you have been insubordinate in that you have failed to follow my directives, on November 27th, November 30, December 1st, 2nd, 7th, 13th, and 19th.

This misconduct and insubordination will lead to further disciplinary action including a U rating for the 2005-2006 school year and charges under the Education Law which may lead to your termination.
