With its main gallery space, a floor to ceiling black box and the pink fur walls in the office, boxx is the most unique gallery in Indianapolis.

Boxx resides on the second floor of the Murphy Art Center. This original section of the building was constructed as a boarding house. Near the turn of the century, the nuns from St Patricks Church lived in these rooms for a period of six years.

It is well known that there are many spirits that reside in the Murphy.

On april 13, 2004 the Indiana Ghost Trackers (their third trip to the building) and Radio Now 93.1’s Wank and O’Brien brought Gary Spivey (a well known medium from CA who has appeared on many shows including Montel Williams) to the space in search of ghosts. The medium made contact with Sister Mary Margaret, a former resident who past away in the space. She was very distraught because she had had sex several times with a man and therefore remained earth bound in fear of being rejected in heaven.
