

## Make a Movie from Images

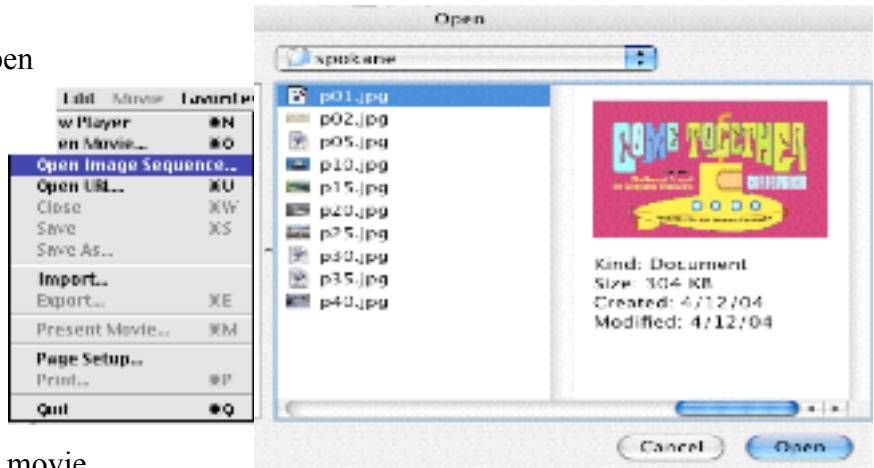
A movie (slide show) can be made from a series of images. This technique can be used to display student work, create an animation, or a movie clip from still images.

### Preparing the Images

1. All of the images must be in a separate folder.
2. All of the images must be named with the same name with sequential numbers. Example: p01.jpg, p02.jpg, p06.jpg, etc. The numbers do not necessarily have to be consecutive. (Note: Photoshop Elements, PhotoShop or Graphic Converter can batch edit the pictures so that all of the names will be consistent)

### Creating the Movie

1. From the File menu, select Open Image Sequence.
2. Navigate to the folder with your images.
3. Click on the first image.



### Select the Speed of the Images

1. Select the speed for the image movie. (30 frames/sec is real time video, 2-5 seconds/frame for a slide show)
2. Experiment with the speed to obtain the desired effect.

### Save the Movie

1. Save the movie in your folder with the name sanantonio.mov
2. Be certain to click **Make Movie Self-contained**.

### Extension

1. Add a title to your movie.
2. Add music to your movie now or wait until you complete the next activities
3. Add music:
  - Open music in QuickTime. Select All. Copy to the clipboard.
  - Add** music to image sequence movie.
4. Save the movie as a **self-contained file**.
