The Generations and Families.

First Generation.

Family No. One.

I. Andries Van Sickelen, (who was probably a son of Rynear and Henah), was born (probably in Hunterdon County) in the State of New Jersey, about the year 1840. He married *Annatie (Hannah) Schomp*, by whom he had three children—one son and two daughters; I. Andrew, who was baptized September 22, 1765; II. Annatie (Hannah), who was baptized January 26, 1772; and III. Sara, who was baptized November 28, 1779; all of whom were baptized in the Dutch Reformed Church of Readington, New Jersey.

Second Generation.

II. Andrew Van Sickle, the first child and only son of Hannah (Schomp) and Andrew, was born (probably in Hunterdon County) in the State of New Jersey, August 28, 1765. He married *Rebecca Lane*, by whom he had seven children; I. Hannah, who was baptized Jan. 13, 1790; II. Ellen, born May 1, 1792; III. Sarah, born Sept. 19, 1794; IV. Andrew, born March 23, 1797; V. Lydia S., born April 30, 1800; VI. Aaron, born Nov. 11, 1802; and VII. Peter, born Jan. 4, 1806, who died July 18, 1817. He was a farmer by occupation. He died June 12, 1815. His wife, Rebecca, was born July 21, 1769, and died May 21, 1838.

3. Hannah Van Sickle, the second child and oldest daughter of Andrew and Hannah, was born (probably in Hunterdon County) in the State of New Jersey, in the year 1772. She married *John Thompson*, by whom she had seven children; I. Andrew, born Sept. 23, 1794,

who married Susannah Lane, and died in August, 1850; II. Judah, born July 17, 1796, who married Aaron L. Saxon; III. John, born Jan. 3, 1798, who married Sarah Emmons, and died in 1845; IV. Peter, born May 25, 1800, who married Mary Ann Biggs, and died in 1844; V. Hannah, born August 1, 1802; VI. Sarah, born June 6, 1804; and VII. Mary, born about 1806. She died January 14, 1806. Her husband, John Thompson, next married ——— *Morehead*.

4. **Sarah Van Sickle**, the third and youngest child of Andrew and Hannah, was born (probably in Hunterdon County) in the State of New Jersey, on the 5th of November, 1779. She married, March 25, 1799, *John Morehead*, by whom she had an only son, John, born March 14, 1804, who died in 1848. She died January 14, 1838, or May 18, 1838.

• Third Generation.

5. **Hannah Van Sickle**, the first child and oldest daughter of Rebecca (Lane) and Andrew, was born in the State of New Jersey about the year 1790. She married *Daniel Amerman*, by whom she had three children; Daniel, (who became a preacher) Andrew, and Henry, (who died in 1872.) They removed to Ohio.

6. **Ellen Van Sickle**, the second child of Andrew and Rebecca, was born in the State of New Jersey, May 1, 1792. She married *James R. Van Sickle*, (who had two sisters—Margaret and Sarah), who was said to be her cousin. They both died without issue. She died March 25, 1852.

7. **Sarah Van Sickle**, the third child of Andrew and Rebecca, was born in the State of New Jersey, September 19, 1794. She married *Jemmy Dawes*, by whom she had five children; John, Josiah, Aaron, Sarah and Mary.

8. **III. Andrew Van Sickle**, the fourth child and oldest son of Andrew and Rebecca, was born in Somerset County, New Jersey, March 23, 1797. He was married in Hunterdon Co., N. J., about the year 1818, to *Eleanor Melick*, by whom he had six children; I. Andrew, born May 15, 1819; II. John M., born Dec. 13, 1820; III. Hannah A., born Feb. 25, 1823; IV. Peter, born April 15, 1825; V. Charles, born March 12, 1832; and VI. Nelson, born Sept. 22, 1838. He was a farmer by occupation. In 1822 he removed to Tompkins County, and from thence, in 1823, to Steuben County, N. Y., where he resided until his death, which occurred in the month of November, 1848. His wife, Eleanor, was born Sept. 6, 1799, and died April 6, 1867.

9. **Lydia Susan Van Sickle**, the fifth child and youngest daughter of Rebecca and Andrew, was born in the State of New Jersey, April 30, 1800. She married *James Melick*, by whom she had ten children; Peter V., who married Elizabeth Post; Anthony, who married Jane Dalley; Rebecca, who married Isaac Philhower; Susan, who married Elias Philhower; Baratine, John, Andrew, James, Mary and Ellen.

10. IV. Aaron Van Sickle, the sixth child of Andrew and Rebecca, was born in Hunterdon County, New Jersey, November 11, 1802; and was married in the same county, to *Eleanor*, daughter of William Orr, by whom he had seven children; I. Rebecca; II. Jane; III. Mary; IV. Sarah, who died at about the age of 19; V. Margaret; VI. Peter; and VII. Aaron L., who died at about the age of 21. He was a farmer by occupation. He died February 23, 1848. His wife, Eleanor, died Sept. 18, 1858, at the age of 54.

Fourth Generation.

12. V. Andrew Van Sickle, the first child and oldest son of Eleanor (Melick) and Andrew, was born in Hunterdon County, New Jersey, May 15, 1819. In 1822, he was taken by his parents to Western New York. About the year 1840, he was married in Steuben County, New York, to *Sarah*, daughter of James Kennedy, of Tompkins County, New York, by whom he had two sons; I. Henry; and II. John K. He was a merchant by occupation. He died on the 30th of January, 1860.

13. VI. John M. Van Sickle, the second child of Andrew and Eleanor, was born in Hunterdon County, New Jersey, December 13, 1820. In 1822 he was taken by his parents to Western New York. He was married in Alleghany County, New York, on the 4th of July, 1842, to *Ethylinda*, daughter of Uriah Nichols, of Massachusetts, by whom he had three children—two sons and one daughter; I. Robert L., born July 20, 1843, who died Nov. 23, 1863; II. Charles A., born May 29, 1848; and III. Emma, born Jan. 18, 1858, who died Aug. 20, 1863. His wife, Ethylinda, was born Nov. 3, 1819. He is a farmer by occupation, and now (1880) resides at Hornellsville, Steuben County, N. Y.

14. Hannah Van Sickle, the third child and only daughter of Andrew and Eleanor, was born in Hunterdon County, New Jersey, February 25, 1823. She was married in Steuben County, New York, about the year 1843, to *Robert Brundage*, lawyer, son of Benjamin Brundage by whom she had two children; I. a son, Frank, born June 29, 1848, who died in 1857; and II. a daughter, Ella, born about 1851. She died December 3, 1865. Her husband now (1880) resides at Hornellsville, Steuben Co., N. Y.

15. VII. Peter Van Sickle, the fourth child of Andrew and Eleanor, was born in Tompkins County, New York, April 15, 1825. He was married in Steuben County, New York, to *Susan*, daughter of Alvah Mead, by whom he had two daughters; I. Ellen; and II. Sarah. He was a merchant by occupation. He died December 10, 1878.

16. VIII. Charles Van Sickle, the fifth child of Andrew and Eleanor, was born in Tompkins County, New York, March 12, 1832. He was married in Steuben County, New York Dec. 1858, to *Sarah*, daughter of Charles Coasting, by whom he had one child, a son, Earnest. He was a farmer by occupation. He died December 26, 1868.

17. IX. Nelson Van Sickle, the sixth and youngest child and son of Andrew and Eleanor, was born in Tompkins County, New York, September 22, 1838. He was married in Alleghany County, New York, to *Eliza*, daughter of Henry Harrison, by whom he had two children, both of whom are deceased. He is also deceased.

18. Rebecca Van Sickle, the first child and oldest daughter of Eleanor (Orr) and Aaron, was born in Hunterdon County, New Jersey, August 24, 1824. She married *John W. Baird*, by whom she had one child, a son, Aaron V. S. She died June 22, 1860.

19. Jane Van Sickle, the second child of Aaron and Eleanor, was born in Hunterdon County, New Jersey, in the year 1827. She married *William Edgart*, by whom she had one child, a son, Peter V. S. She died in 1856.

20. Mary Van Sickle, the third child of Aaron and Eleanor, was born in Hunterdon County, New Jersey, in the year 1830. She married *Henry Emmons*. No children. She died September 12, 1861.

22. Margaret Van Sickle, the fifth child of Aaron and Eleanor, was born in Hunterdon County, New Jersey, December 31, 1835. She was married in Somerset County, New Jersey, December 24, 1850, to *William C. Conklin*, son of John Conklin, by whom she had three children; I. Henry, born Sept. 4, 1863; II. Campfield, born Dec. 29, 1869; and III. George W., born Jan. 13, 1873. She now (1880) resides in Readington Township, Hunterdon Co., New Jersey. P. O., Readington.

23. X. Peter Van Sickle, the sixth child and oldest son of Aaron and Eleanor, was born in Hunterdon County, New Jersey, in the year 1839. He married *Mary Jane Smith*, by whom he had two sons, John and Aaron. He died June 30, 1874.

Fifth Generation.

28. XI. Charles A. Van Sickle, the second child and youngest son of John M. and Ethylinda, was born in Alleghany County, New York, May 29, 1848. He was married in Livingston County, New York, March 2, 1876, to *Abbie*, daughter of Henry Belts, of Steuben County, New York, by whom he had one child, a daughter, Allie, born Dec. 1, 1876. He now (1880) resides at Hornellsville, Steuben Co., N. Y., and is a conductor on the Erie R. R.
