Your Life Time Line Project

Your time line needs to include at least 10 important dates from your life. You must create your time line on PowerPoint. You are required to sketch out your time line on paper and receive approval from me before you may use the computer. We will spend the next several weeks working on the projects in the room and on the computers.

Your project will be graded on having at least 10 dates, creativity, originality, neatness, and thoroughness of the time line. You must create your presentation in a HyperLink format, as opposed to a linear format. There must be an introductory page, a timeline page, and one page for each event. There must be a link from the timeline to each event page, and from each event page back to the timeline page.

Each of your event pages must have a picture that closely approximates the age you were when that event took place. It is preferable to have a picture of the event itself if possible. You may draw a maximum of four of the ten events.

Please discuss with your parents each event, and get as many details as you can. Any pictures you can find may be brought in to me to be scanned, or you may scan them at home. If you do scan them at home, please scan them into a .jpg (Jpeg) format.

Each event page will also contain a summary of the event. Spelling and grammar will be considered in these summaries.

Please be as consistent as possible between event pages. Consider font color, size and formatting carefully. Consistency is the key. Do not design something that will be distracting to the reader, and make sure the contrast between font color and background color. You want it to be easily read by your audience.
