

## Using XP Service Pack 1 with Boot Camp

---

The following procedures are for installing **Windows XP Service Pack 1(a)** onto an Intel Mac using Boot Camp.

---

To install drivers found on your machine (which were extracted from the Boot Camp Drivers CD when you first ran the installer):

1. Run the Boot Camp Install CD within Windows until it encounters an error and quits.
2. Navigate to the following directory within Windows:  
C Drive > Program Files > Macintosh Drivers for Windows XP
3. There should be a series of folders labeled with different names, these contain the different drivers for your machine. Some of them are obvious (ATI Graphics), some of them aren't (filter), but in any case you should be able to load a few of the more obvious ones via Control Panel > System > Hardware > Device Manager.
4. Once in device manager find the "unknown devices" and then load drivers into these devices. Sometimes Windows will pop up with random "found new hardware" messages which can also be used to load drivers.

To install a few more drivers found on the web on your machine:

1. Navigate to the following URL and download the appropriate driver you wish to use:

2. Then install it using the same process described above.

Restart your computer, and then most drivers should be properly loaded (at least enough for Windows to function properly).
