

GLOBAL YOUTH INSTITUTE
Student Behavior Agreement

The Global Youth Institute is sponsored and administered by the Des Moines Public Schools and the Friendship Force of Greater Des Moines. The rules of the Des Moines Public School Discipline Policy will be in effect during all Institute academic sessions and all Institute-sponsored activities and will be enforced by all participating staff.

- I. The Discipline Policy shall apply to students:
 - A. while on all Institute premises;
 - B. while on school-owned and operated school buses or on chartered buses;
 - C. while engaged in Institute-sponsored activities; and
 - D. while away from Institute premises if such conduct would directly affect the good order, efficiency, management and welfare of the Institute.

- II. Violations of the Discipline Policy may include any of the following:
 - A. possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages;
 - B. possession, use or sale of any controlled substance;
 - C. smoking during Institute-sponsored activities;
 - D. excessive displays of affection;
 - E. display of intolerance based on age, race, creed, color, sex, national origin, religion, sexual orientation or disability;
 - F. violation of any rule established by the institute for the safety and well being of the participants and the Institute.

(In the State of Iowa the legal age for drinking alcohol is 21 and smoking is 18)

- III. Any violation of this policy can result in dismissal from the program. If a student is found in violation, the student may be returned home at the parent's expense. Parents will be notified if a violation occurs. Notification may also be sent to the administration of the school in which the student is enrolled.
